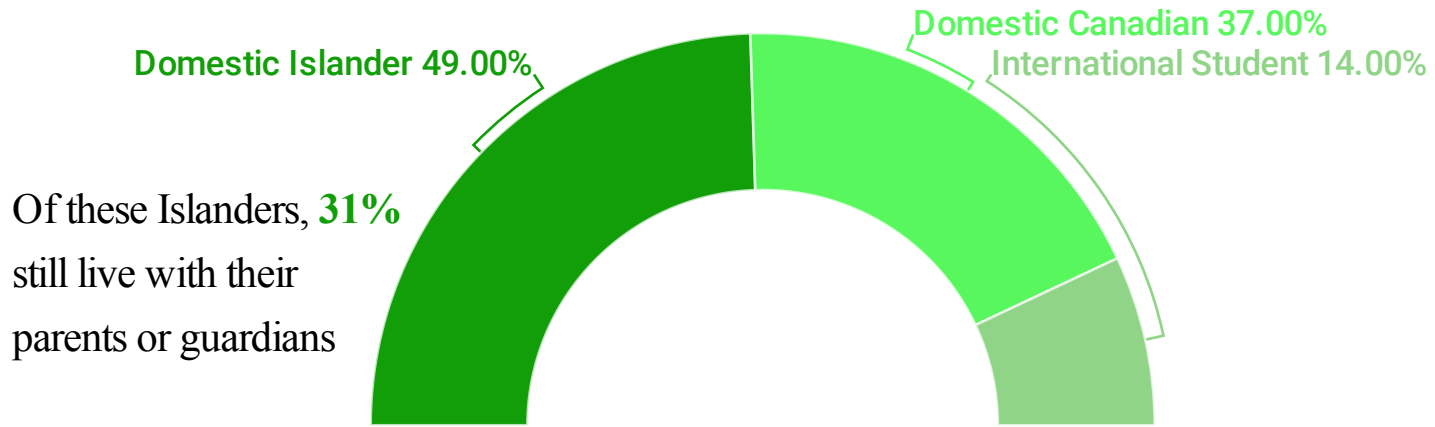
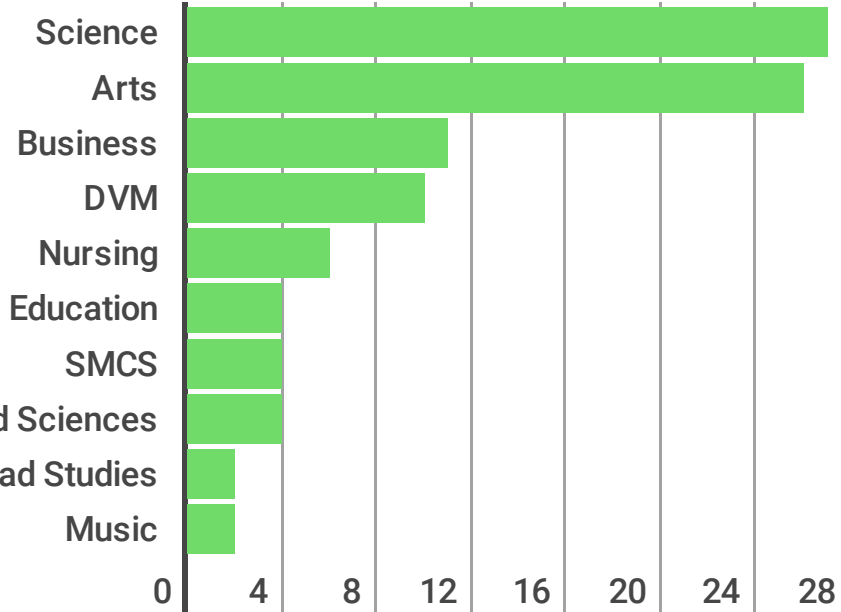

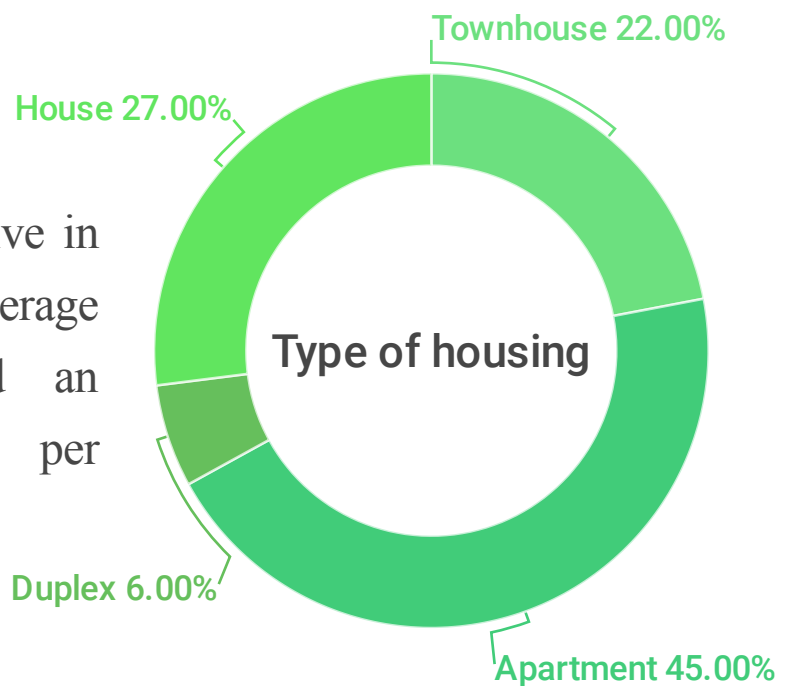
2% of students preferred not to declare their identity, 1 student identified as a Trans Man



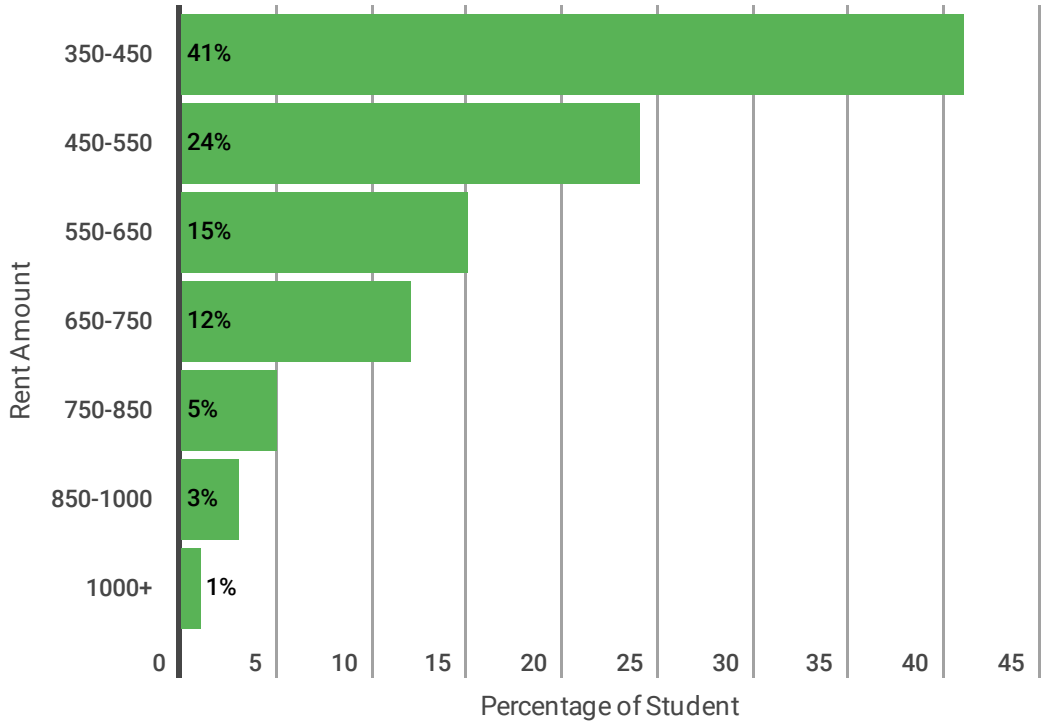
For those who do not live with their parents, 70% live over 15km from the University



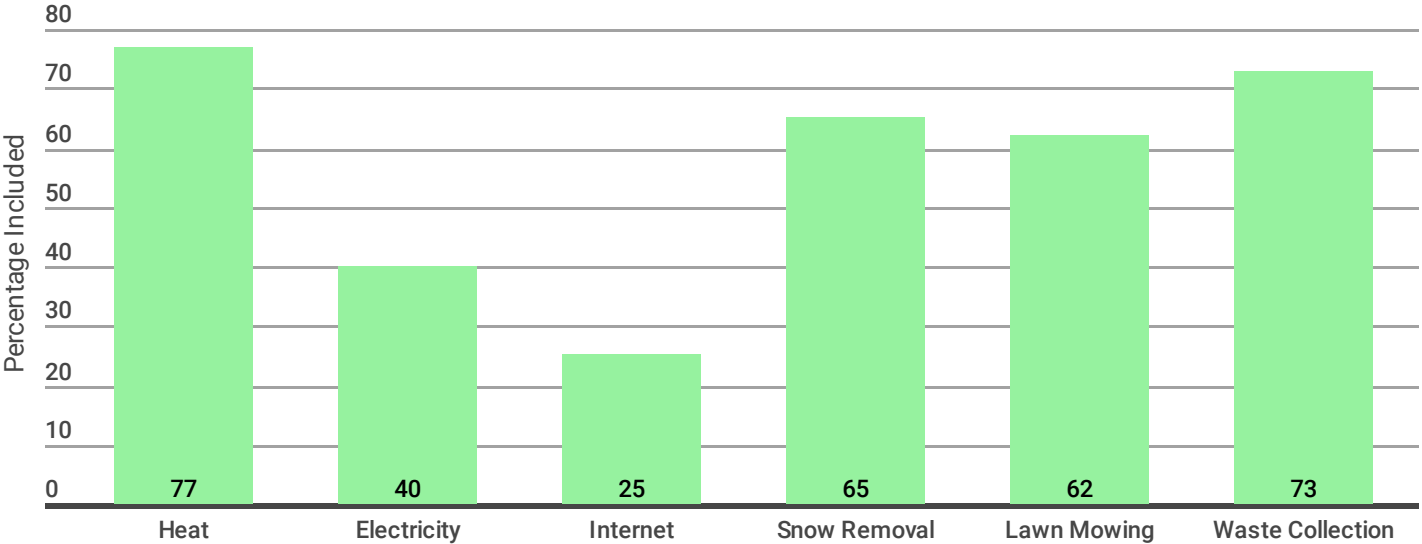
For other students, they live in housing units with an average of 2.5 bedrooms, and an average of 2.9 people per household



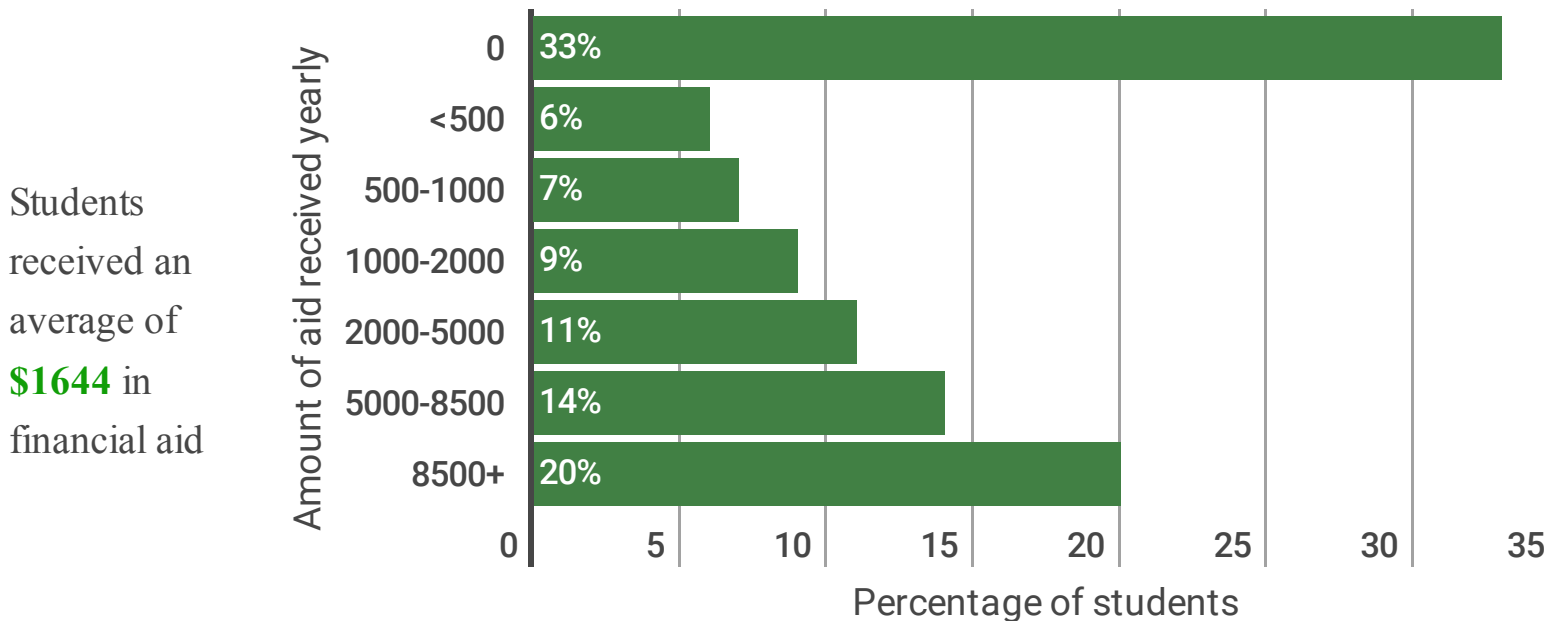
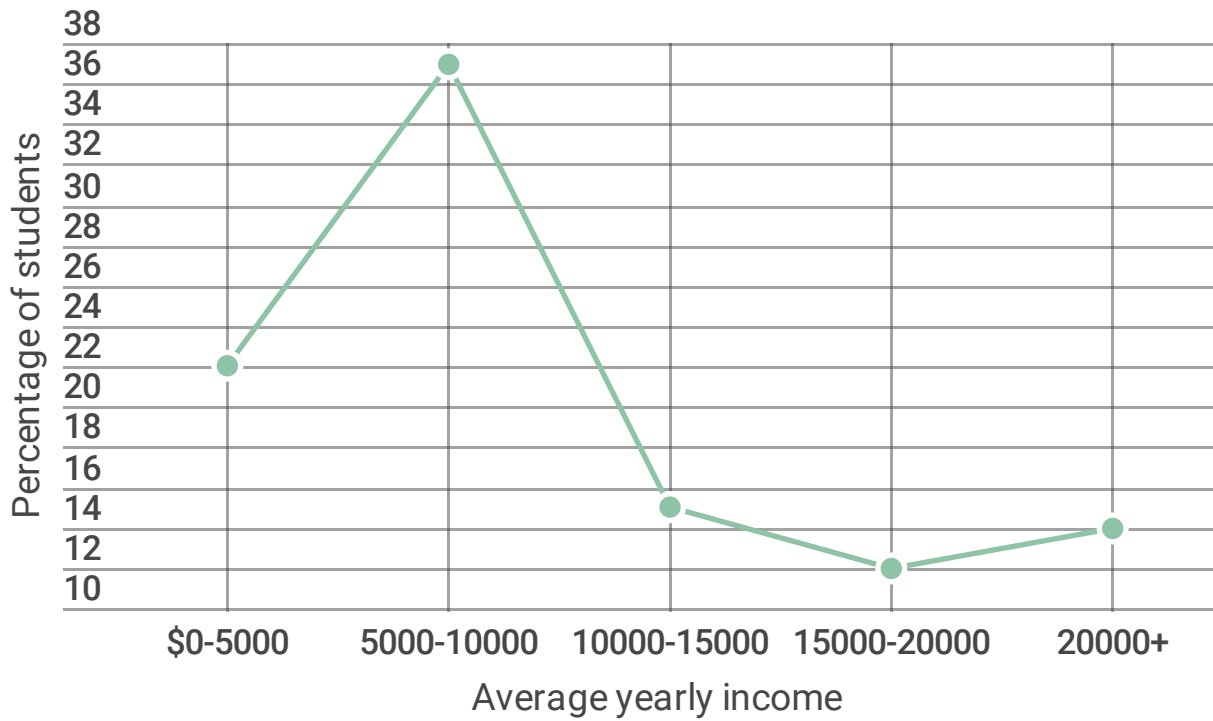
The average rent paid by students per month is **\$538**

**54%** of students said that their full-time studies were affected by the cost of housing  
**41%** of students stated that their housing situation has affected their academic ability



**66%** of students stated that the current 0.9% Vacancy rate has affected their ability to move from their current housing unit



**45%** of students living away from their family said they intended to leave Prince Edward Island after their studies.

Of this, **46%** said they would stay if the housing situation was different

**55%** of students living with their parents/guardians said they intended to leave Prince Edward Island after their studies.
